

# Barriers and enablers of access to good end-of-life care for 2SLGBTQIA+ people

A rapid review was designed and conducted based on an adapted Preferred Reporting Items for Systematic Reviews and Meta-Analyses extension for Scoping Reviews Checklist.

34 articles were included from 6 electronic databases.


**What helps 2SLGBTQIA+ people from access good end-of-life care?**
